Updates From Administration

Hello, Families and Friends,

We have recently performed precautionary testing on some of the residents and staff due to a possible exposure. At this time, there are no confirmed Covid-19 cases at the facility. However, one of our units will remain on quarantine through next week as additional tests results are confirmed. Due to the possible exposure, we had to temporarily suspend outdoor activities, but will be hopeful by next week the residents will be able to go outdoors again! When we get to our next phase the recreational therapists are able to complete a one-on-one outdoor visits with each resident 2-3 times per week. In addition, we are able to complete small group activities (6 or less) on the units with social distancing and the use of surgical face masks. We will continue to update all parties as we progress to different phases of reopening.

We will notify families when we can open up for scheduled resident visits. Our team understands how hard these past months have been not being able to visit your loved ones. We continue to ensure our top priority as a facility is the safety of our staff and residents.

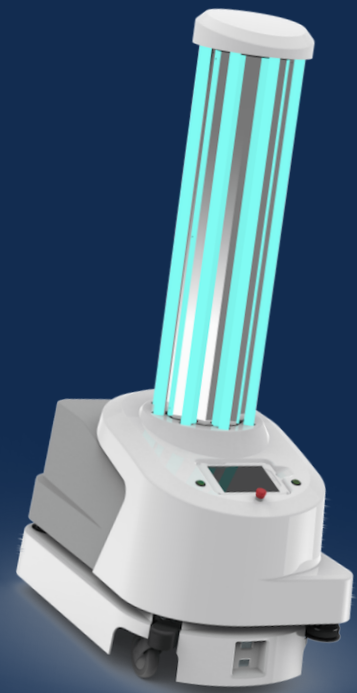
DCHC Goes Under Construction!

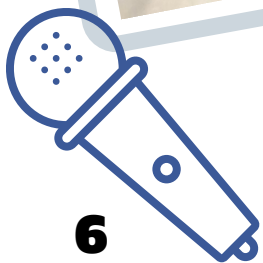
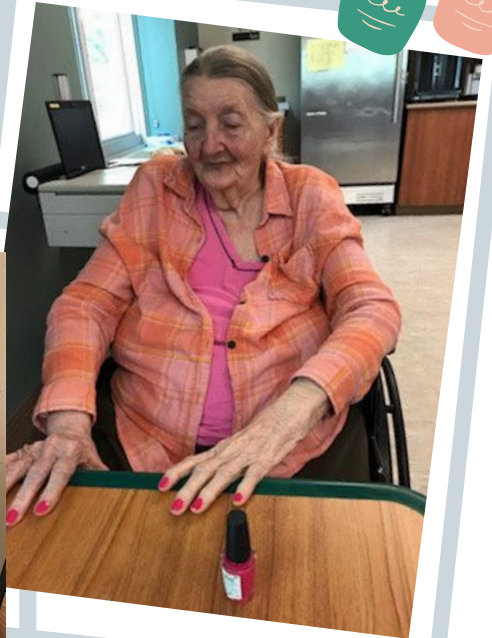
Time Spent Outdoors

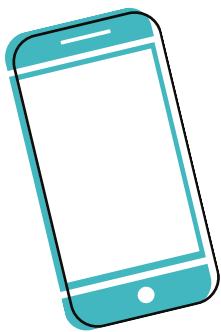
Our Recreational Therapy team is assisting residents to spend time in our outdoor gardens!

Want to Connect with *Your Loved One?*



Have a iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch?

We've got iPads at DCHC so you can Facetime your loved one!

How To Steps Below:

Using it on iPhone, iPad, iPod touch To place a FaceTime call on your iOS device, you need the person's phone number or email address. Remember, they also need a compatible Apple device and to have FaceTime enabled.

Now, you've got a few options:

1. Say, "Hey, Siri, FaceTime [person's name]."
2. Tap to open the FaceTime app, tap the plus sign and type the person's phone number or email address. Choose either an audio call, which is the phone icon, or video call, the video camera icon. If you have the person's phone number or email address saved in your contacts, you can begin typing the name and it will appear. Tap the name when you see it.
3. Or start a FaceTime video call from your iPhone during a regular phone call. While chatting, tap the FaceTime icon in the phone app to switch immediately to FaceTime.

Have a smart phone or computer with a camera?

We've got tablets at DCHC so you can Skype your loved one!

How To Steps Below:

1. Download the Skype App
2. Open Skype app and use created email and password to sign in
3. Once in account you will be able to type in a Skype name, email or mobile number
4. You will be able to choose to call or video call this individual with two optional icons
