We want to thank all of you for your understanding over the last few months. The COVID- 19 pandemic has been an unprecedented challenge and has forced us to make changes to our normal processes. We continue to follow all CMS guidelines as we focus on the safety and well being of our residents.

As the DCHC team is developing a reopening plan for the facility, there are a few key short term goals that we would like to accomplish. We hope to return to Phase 1 soon:

- Allowing the residents to spend time on their units outside of their rooms
- Allowing the residents to go outside to one of our Courtyards
- Allowing residents in small groups (less than 6) to have activities
- Allowing residents to eat in the dining room in small groups (less than 6)
