To Our Residents, Resident Representatives and Family Members:

We currently have four neighborhoods on quarantine due to possible staff exposure. At this time, there is no visitation restrictions throughout the facility. However, when visiting please stop at the front desk and they can inform you of any neighborhoods that are in quarantine. We do ask you to social distance from other residents and staff and wear a mask when visiting your loved one.

We will continue to follow all guidance regarding infection control measures to maintain the safety of all our residents, visitors, and staff. Currently, we are providing twice weekly Covid-19 testing of all unvaccinated staff members in an effort to stop any spread of the virus within the facility.
