To Our Residents, Resident Representatives and Family Members:

We currently have all neighborhoods on quarantine due to staff exposure as we have had several staff members test positive over the last few weeks. At this time, we do not have any neighborhoods with active resident cases. However, when visiting please stop at the front desk and they can inform you of any status updates for the facility. We do ask you to social distance from other residents and staff and wear a mask and face shield when visiting your loved one.

We will continue to follow all guidance regarding infection control measures to maintain the safety of all our residents, visitors, and staff. Currently, we are providing twice weekly Covid-19 testing of all unvaccinated staff members in an effort to stop any spread of the virus within the facility.

Resident Vaccination Rate: 98% Staff Vaccination Rate: 95%
