VI. DCHC/CMHC Routine Reports

& Updates

a. Admin Update Erin Nelson, Maureen Boyle and Jim Cavanaugh were speaking.

Ms Nelson provided a COVID-19 update. She reviewed the vaccine mandated that was just issued by the CDC for all long term care facilities and provided an update on visitation guidelines. She also provided an update on the new Dietary system slated to be available in Spring 2022. The Veterans Administration conducted a survey with no findings and we will be consuming our contract with them in the page fetture.

renewing our contract with them in the near future.

Ms Nelson also provided data on the staffing issues within DCHC and anticipates that we'll see an increase in the number of applicants due to the temporary salary increase for nursing positions approved by the Board of Commissioners. Staff is focusing on improving resident behaviors by purchasing an interactive computer software designed specifically for dementia patients and hiring additional recreation staff to assist with more activities and outings as well as contracting with a counseling service who specialize in geriatrics. She also reported that DCHC is returning to pre-COVID level activities for the residents including holiday celebrations.

The Trustees inquired about staff burnout, CMS guidelines, staffing issues and admissions.

b. CMHC Routine Reports Mike Phillips and Maureen Boyle were speaking.
