To Our Residents, Resident Representatives and Family Members:

We currently have one neighborhood on quarantine due to a positive resident case .At this time, we do not have any positive staff. However, when visiting please stop at the front desk and they can inform you of any status updates for the facility. We do ask you to social distance from other residents and staff and wear a mask when visiting your loved one.

We will continue to follow all guidance regarding infection control measures to maintain the safety of all our residents, visitors, and staff. Currently, we are providing twice weekly Covid-19 testing of all unvaccinated staff members in an effort to stop any spread of the virus within the facility. Our vaccination rate for both staff and residents are higher than the State and National averages! We are happy to see the cases diminishing and looking forward to the end of this pandemic.
