VI. DCHC/CMHC Routine Reports

& Updates

a. Admin Update Erin Nelson is speaking.

Ms Nelson provided a facility update on COVID-19. She included data for the both nationally and at DCHC regarding vaccinations, COVID-19 cases. A discussion was held on red and yellow zones. She also reported on the LB108 funding, intergovernmental transfer and the increase in Medicaid rates. An update on admissions was included as well as bed availability and potential changes to the three (3) and four (4) bed rooms.

Ms Nelson highlighted the Therapy departments, speech, occupational and physical provided by Choice Therapy and some added equipment and technology they've added to their services. She reviewed the staff positions and the social, spiritual and individualized activities they provide the residents. A list of enhancements was reviewed such as the Lucent Magic Table, Sonifi which provides live events and movies, etc. to residents unable to attend in person just to name a few.

Data on FTE's, turnover rates and nursing mandates were reviewed as well as the new Meet & Greet sessions that are being held as well as innovative ideas designed to create a positive and harmonious environment for employees to work in.
