a. Admin Update

Erin Nelson is speaking.

Ms. Nelson provided an overview on ARPA Funding Info LB 1014, covid vaccinations, Federal Staffing Mandates, LB227-Complex Patients Grant, American Heart Association Stroke Project and Immigration Workforce Project. She also reported on the new signage project and the current census. Ms Nelson also included a graph of employee headcount and turnover from 2017 to current as well as the current FTE's and the number of staff. Discussion was held on the need for hospice care in the community as well as mental health care and the shortage of Medicaid beds. Ms Nelson also shared that vaccinations are no longer free since we are no longer in an americancy situation.

Sherry Driver is speaking.

Ms. Driver provided July highlights for the inpatient unit regarding medical screening, patient demographics, payer and referral sources, length of stay and discharge status and primary and secondary diagnoses. Staff is working with clients to reduce recidivism. They are also working with family members to assist the client in this area. Clients can take longer to stabilize and may have to wait for a residential bed if the staff feels it is in their best interest.

Ms Driver also reviewed impatient admissions and occupancy, discharges, average lengths of stay. For the outpatient clinic, she provided data for program admissions, triage, nurse, MD/APRN and therapist appointments. She reported that Day Treatment Is still closed but staff are working to get it reopened. Chair Borgeson asked if staff could studyindividuals receiving long acting injectables and the impact that has over the next year of treatment.
