Educare

We are extending the deadline for completing the 1st Quarter *Educare* training modules to April 15th. We have also added an 18 minute **COVID-19 Precautions** training module. *We are asking that you complete this module by this Thursday.* You will receive an *additional one hour* on your 4/21/20 paycheck.

SICK LEAVE

You must assume COVID-19 is in our communities. The best protection you can take is to maintain a **social distance** when you are out of your home. CDC is also now recommending that everyone <u>wear a mask in public places</u>. You can take your work mask home (in a brown paper bag) and reuse it in public.

If you have symptoms (*dry cough, fever, shortness of breath*) call the charge nurse prior to coming to work. You will most likely be directed to go to a clinic and get tested for COVID-19. As an employee of an essential health care service, you meet the criteria that you will get tested.

Of the area clinics, we *currently* know RC Hospital in Olivia has 24/7 testing set up and gets results fairly quickly (*it is best to call ahead* 800.916.1836) **Be sure to tell your clinic that you work at a care center.**

If you test positive <u>or</u> are waiting results of a COVID-19 test, you will be eligible for up to two weeks of paid sick leave (<u>your PPL hours will not be used for this</u>). The hours paid will be based on the average hours you work, up to 40 hours per week. This benefit is part of the Federal Emergency Families First Coronavirus Act (FFCRA).
